Nicole holds degrees from the University of Albany and Carnegie Mellon University and graduated from Leadership Baltimore (2020-2021).



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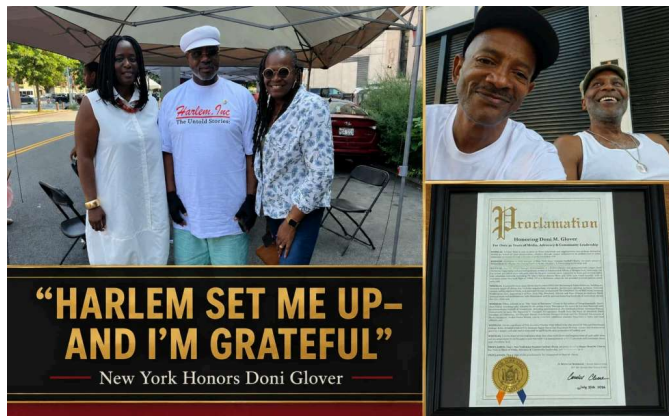
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
